

The first-grade entry skills list acts as a guide for parents and teachers in determining correct placement of a child who was home schooled for kindergarten. It is a resource that is supplemental to testing.

Students entering first grade at Faith Christian Academy should be able to:

Physical/Social:

- Listen and follow directions
- Raise hand to ask questions
- Be quiet and orderly in hallways and restrooms
- Concentrate long enough to complete a task
- Sit for 30-minute periods at a time
- Act respectfully toward other students and their property
- Use restroom independently, including zippers and belts
- Tie shoes
- Verbally express opinions, feelings, and needs

Handwriting:

- Form uppercase and lowercase manuscript letters legibly
- Write first and last name
- Understand the concept of spacing
- Write numerals 0-20
- Routinely properly erase, slant paper, and maintain writing posture

Reading Readiness:

- Articulate letter names and their main sounds (including short and long vowels)
- Sound out beginning letter sounds in words
- Sound out short vowel words
- Sound out long vowel words with silent final e
- Fluently read a simple story containing short vowel words and some sight words with 90% accuracy
- Sound out some two- and three-letter consonant blends (sh, th, ck)
- Correctly write from dictation 80% of the two-letter phonograms as introduced with the Sansari cards
- Fluently read color words, number words, and first 50 sight words from Fry list

Language:

- Speak in complete sentences
- Use appropriate voice tone for age

Math:

- Add and subtract with concrete manipulatives up to ten
- Recognize and write numerals 0-100
- Recite the seven days in a week and the twelve months in a year
- Understand basic spatial relationships
- Identify basic shapes
- Tells time to the hour
- Can name coins and give values to a penny, nickel, dime, and quarter
